

Upon recognizing Jesus, Simeon prophesies that "this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel," and that Mary herself will be pierced. Malachi warns, "Who will endure the day of his coming?" Clearly the appearance of God is not all fun and games. A prominent theme throughout the remainder of Luke's Gospel is that the revelation of God prompts a choice. If we recognize the presence of God in Jesus Christ, do we choose to follow or do we walk away?


