### **Pentecost**

**Theme:** the Holy Spirit, Gift of the Father. A full-rigged ship under an unfurled sail makes a beautiful picture, but it does not move without wind. Without "the breath of life," human beings cannot perform. An artist needs inspiration. The "ruah Yahweh" - the breath, animating Spirit, of God—was given to us at baptism. On the fiftieth day after Easter (Passover) the Jews celebrated the giving of the Mosaic Law at Sinai and the establishment of Israel as God's people. At Pentecost we celebrate the giving of the Spirit to God's people and, related to it, the establishment of the new Israel, the church.

The Spirit, whom the Lord Jesus sends from the Father, will remind us of all that the Lord has taught us. He will animate us and help us to know and understand our religion not just with our mind but also with our heart and soul (Jn 14:26).

For a more profound insight into the mystery of Pentecost, we should refer to the introduction to both Easter time, and the Pentecost Vigil. Pentecost marks the conclusion of the "great fifty days," Easter Time. -St. Joseph Missal

In his Pentecost homily the late Pope Francis reminded his listeners that God asked Noah, Abraham and Moses to do new things. The disciples were also doing something new when Galileans were speaking, but people from other places were hearing in their native languages. Francis asks us the following questions:

Let us ask ourselves today: Are we open to "God's surprises"? Or are we closed and fearful before the newness of the Holy Spirit? Do we have the courage to strike out along the new paths which God's newness sets before us, or do we resist, barricaded in transient structures which have lost their capacity for openness to what is new? We would do well to ask ourselves these questions all through the day.




